One Grand Prize of \$2,000 will be awarded. In addition, an NRSF video producer will create the PSA of the Grand Prize winner's concept.

One runner-up will receive \$1,000. If the entry form of the Grand Prize winner and the Runner-Up are co-signed by a teacher, those teachers will receive a \$100 gift card.
